What is it?

USDA Certified Organic.

What products carry it?

All Badger Balms, Cocoa Butter Lip Balms, Classic Lip Balms, Massage Oils, Body Oils, Baby Oil, Anti-Bug Shake & Spray and Anti-Bug Stick.

Who regulates it?

The United States Department of Agriculture's National Organic Program.



What is it?

Leaping Bunny Certified Cruelty Free – No Animal Testing.

What products carry it?

All Badger products.

Who regulates it?

The Coalition for Consumer Information on Cosmetics.

This happy little logo means that we never test on animals, and neither do our suppliers. Learn more at www.leapingbunny.org

A product Certified Organic by the USDA must contain at least 95% Certified Organic ingredients. The remaining 5% must be safe ingredients from a USDA approved list. This means that the Badger facility, as well as all of our suppliers, have been certified by the same set of regulations. It's a lengthy process, and very strict. **This seal lets you know that our products are completely free of synthetic chemicals, GMOs, and pesticides.** Learn more at www.ams.usda.gov/nop. Products not able to bear the USDA seal contain Certified Organic base ingredients and Essential Oil fragrances.



What is it?

Fair Trade Certified™ Ingredients.

Which products carry it?

Cocoa Butter Lip Balms, Creamy Cocoa Every Day Body Moisturizer, and Lip Tint & Shimmers.

Who regulates it?

Fair Trade USA.

What is it?

Certified Natural

What products carry it?

Currently only our sunscreens bear the seal, but all of our products are certified.

Who regulates it?

The Natural Products Association.
