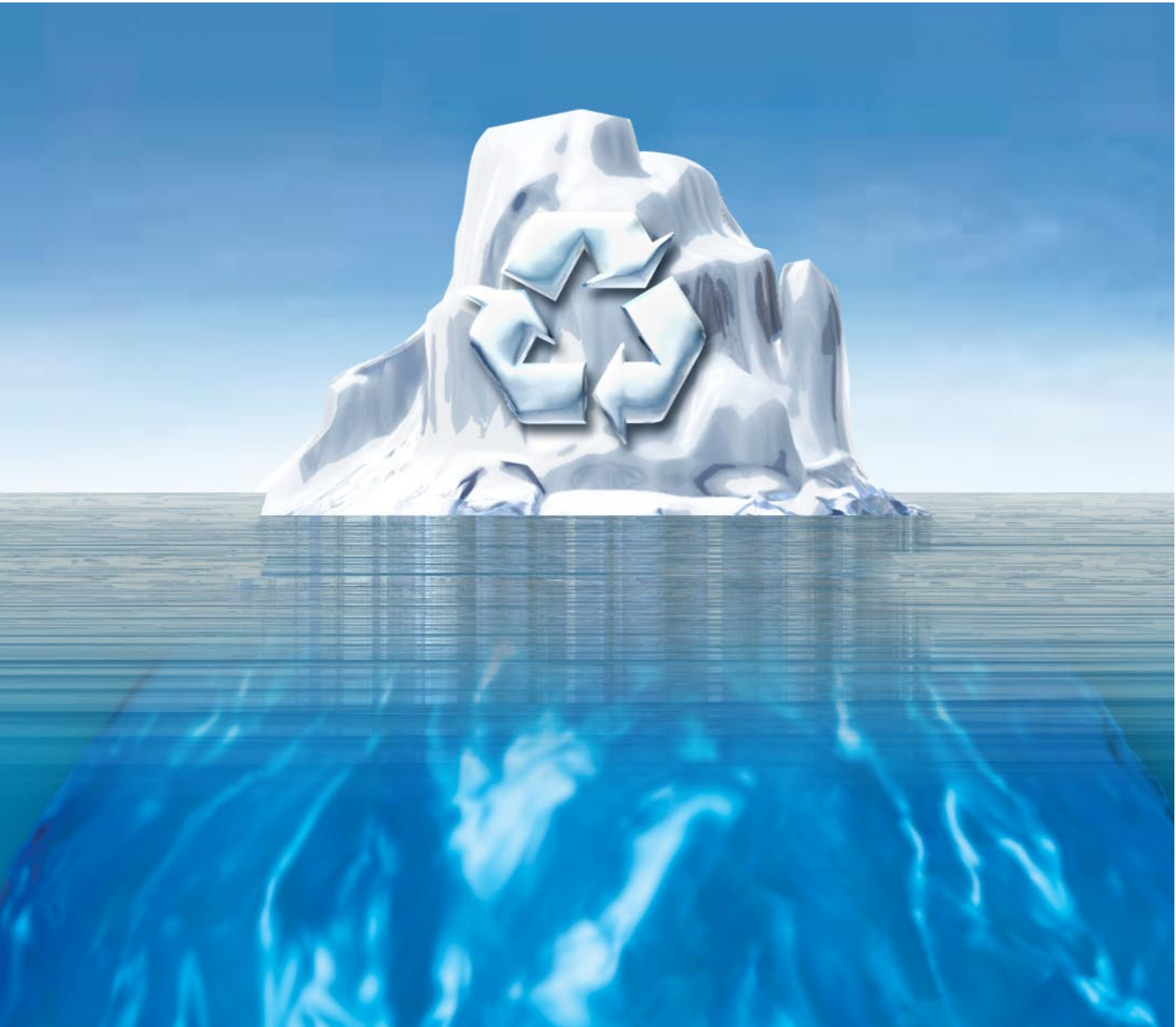

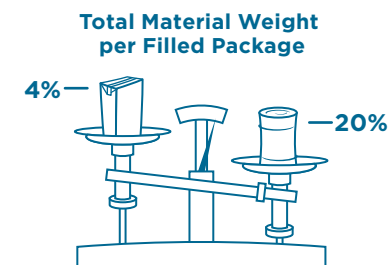
Renewable Resources

A sustainable package is made from a renewable resource, which can be replenished and can last indefinitely. Unlike cans and bottles, Tetra Pak cartons are made of paperboard, a completely renewable and stable resource. Our goal is that all paperboard will come from forests certified by the Sustainable Forestry Initiative, which preserves biological diversity and protects endangered species.



Reduced Packaging

A sustainable package minimizes the amount of materials used to maximize the economic and environmental benefits for brand owners and retailers. Because of its unique six layers of protection, Tetra Pak aseptic cartons use less material and are among the lightest packages on the market. This makes it cost and energy efficient for manufacturing, shipping and storing.
